**Update**

Welcome to the weekly press briefing of the Kosovo Specialist Chambers, where we aim to provide journalists with an update on the latest developments at the court, a look ahead at next week and the opportunity to ask questions.

In the case of Mr Salih Mustafa, trial hearings have been held throughout the course of this week. The Defence for Mr Mustafa has so far called four witnesses to testify, since opening its case last week. Both the Defence and the Prosecution, as well as Victims' Counsel and the Trial Panel have put questions to some of the witnesses. The great majority of testimony has taken place in public session.

The trial is scheduled to continue next Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday.

In the Pjetër Shala case, the next status conference has been scheduled for 14 April.

On 25 March, a Court of Appeals Panel denied appeals by Jakup Krasniqi and Rexhep Selimi against the decisions of the Pre-Trial Judge, ordering their continued detention.
